Who is my neighbor?

On Sunday, I tried to speak about how Jesus has enlarged the neighborhood so that it includes the entire world. One person mentioned to me that we would always have the poor with us and so if we are going to help our neighbors then we can expect to be poor ourselves. This raised for them the question of how to develop a plan, strategy of how much is enough when responding to the "neighbor."

I think this would be my economic response. If you think of a response in terms of the biblical tithe it is helpful. Thus if you think of 5% for the church community and the other 5% as being given to other neighbors you have a system to control your finances in a generous way and still protect your family and your future. But if you are in a high economic bracket then your tithe should be in the 20 – 40% range.

I hope this is helpful. Fr. Dick
